


If you've ever said the wrong thing – or said the right thing the wrong way – you know how quickly your mouth can make a big mess. But it doesn't have to be that way.

Three Kinds of Groups:



GROW

Grow Groups gather to study, learn, and grow together. It could be a discussion around the last week's sermon, a video topical study, or a book of the Bible. Some groups focus more on study while others more on socializing. You'll find a gauge to clarify the focus of each group.
